Language matters. Let's replace terms like "addict" and "junkie" with smarter language that aligns with the science. Replace the "A" word with "individuals with a substance use disorder."

Dos	Don'ts
Substance Use Disorder	Substance abuse/dependence
Individual with a Substance Use Disorder	Addict; Drug abuser; Junkie; Druggie
In recovery; In remission	Clean; Staying clean
Has a Substance Use Disorder	Drug habit
Negative drug test; Not currently using substances	Clean drug test
Positive drug test; Currently using substances	Dirty drug test
