

Signs of an Overdose



- ⚙️ Loss of consciousness
- ⚙️ Unresponsive to outside stimulus
- ⚙️ Awake, but unable to talk
- ⚙️ Hands, face, or lips turning blue, purple, or gray
- ⚙️ Choking sounds, or a snore-like gurgling noise
- ⚙️ Breathing that is slow, shallow, erratic, or has stopped
- ⚙️ Pulse that is slow, erratic, or has stopped
- ⚙️ Vomiting
- ⚙️ Face is pale or clammy
- ⚙️ Not responding to pain
- ⚙️ Body is very limp

If you suspect someone is experiencing an overdose:

1. Call 911 immediately
2. Administer Narcan if available
