## Facts:

- The Health Levy is a one-half (0.5) mill replacement levy that will help cover the operating costs of the Warren County Combined Health District for the next 10 years.
- The average home owner in Warren County will pay 4¢ a day for continued health services.
- Public health is a branch of public services devoted to preventing disease/injury, promoting good health through organized community efforts and protecting the public from communicable diseases.
- The Warren County Combined Health District touches the lives of Warren County residents from infants to the elderly by:
  - Inspecting restaurants and grocery stores to make sure food is safe and to educate operators on food safety.
  - Making sure that water and sewage systems are safe.
  - Keeping the community free from infectious and communicable diseases.
  - Making home visits to address concerns about family health and public nuisances.
  - Giving immunizations for all ages to prevent illness.
  - Inspecting public swimming pools and schools.
  - Providing certified birth and death records.
  - Ongoing development of new programs to meet emerging public health needs like H1N1 Flu and Emergency Response.
