

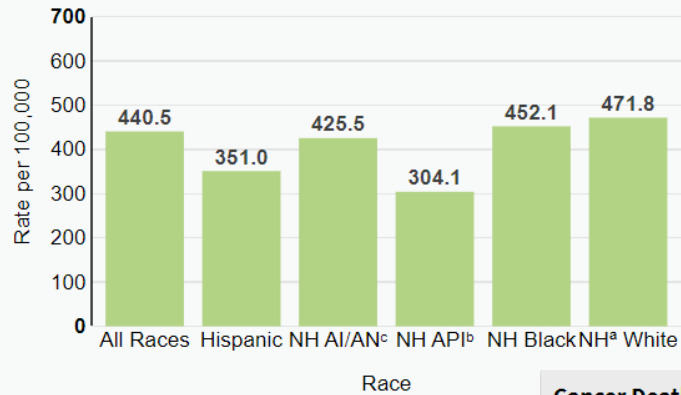

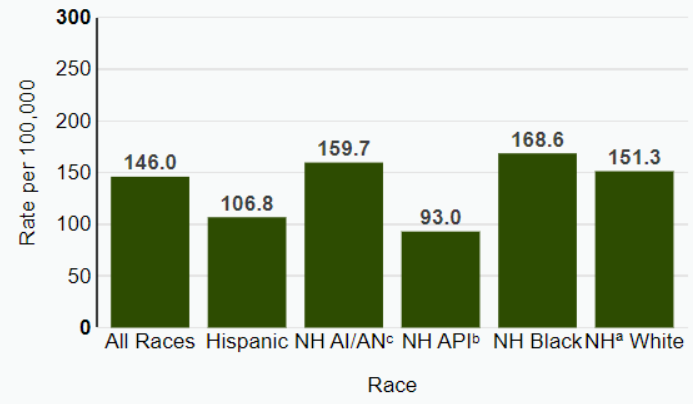


Rates of New Cancer Cases by Race/Ethnicity

Cancer Death Rates by Race/Ethnicity

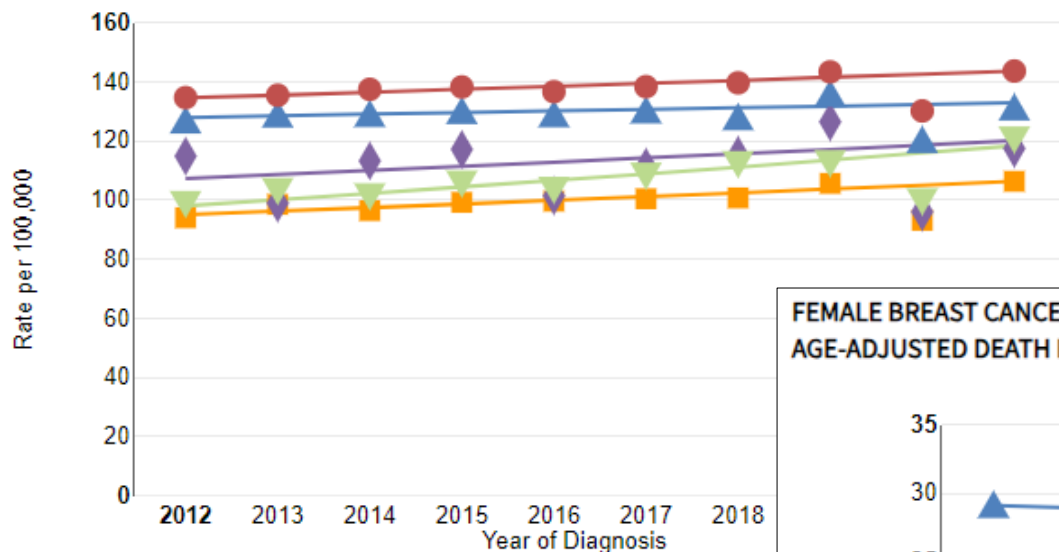


U.S. Mortality 2018–2022, Age-Adjusted Rate per 100,000
^a Non-Hispanic, ^b Asian/Pacific Islander, ^c American Indian/Alaska Native

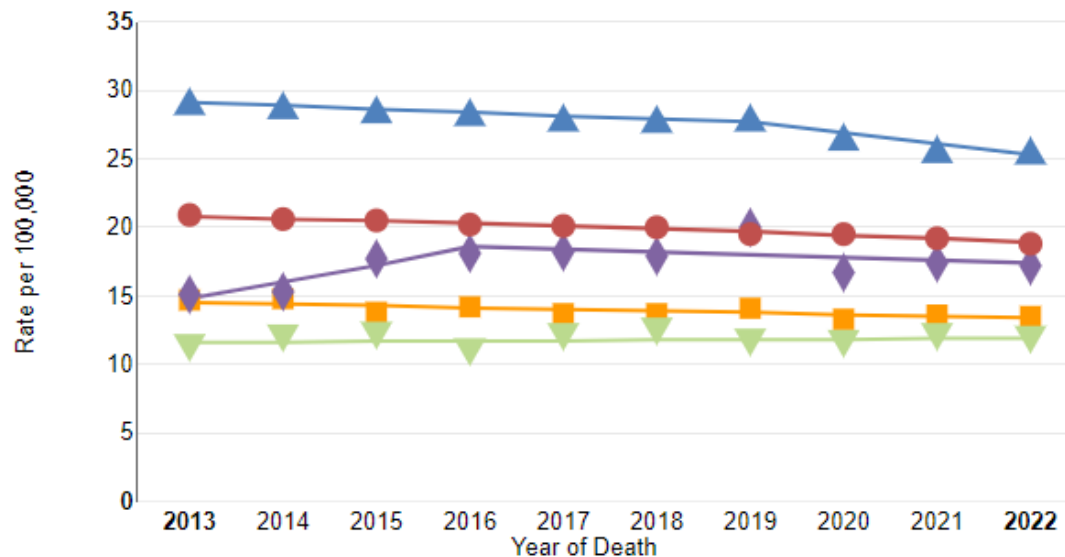

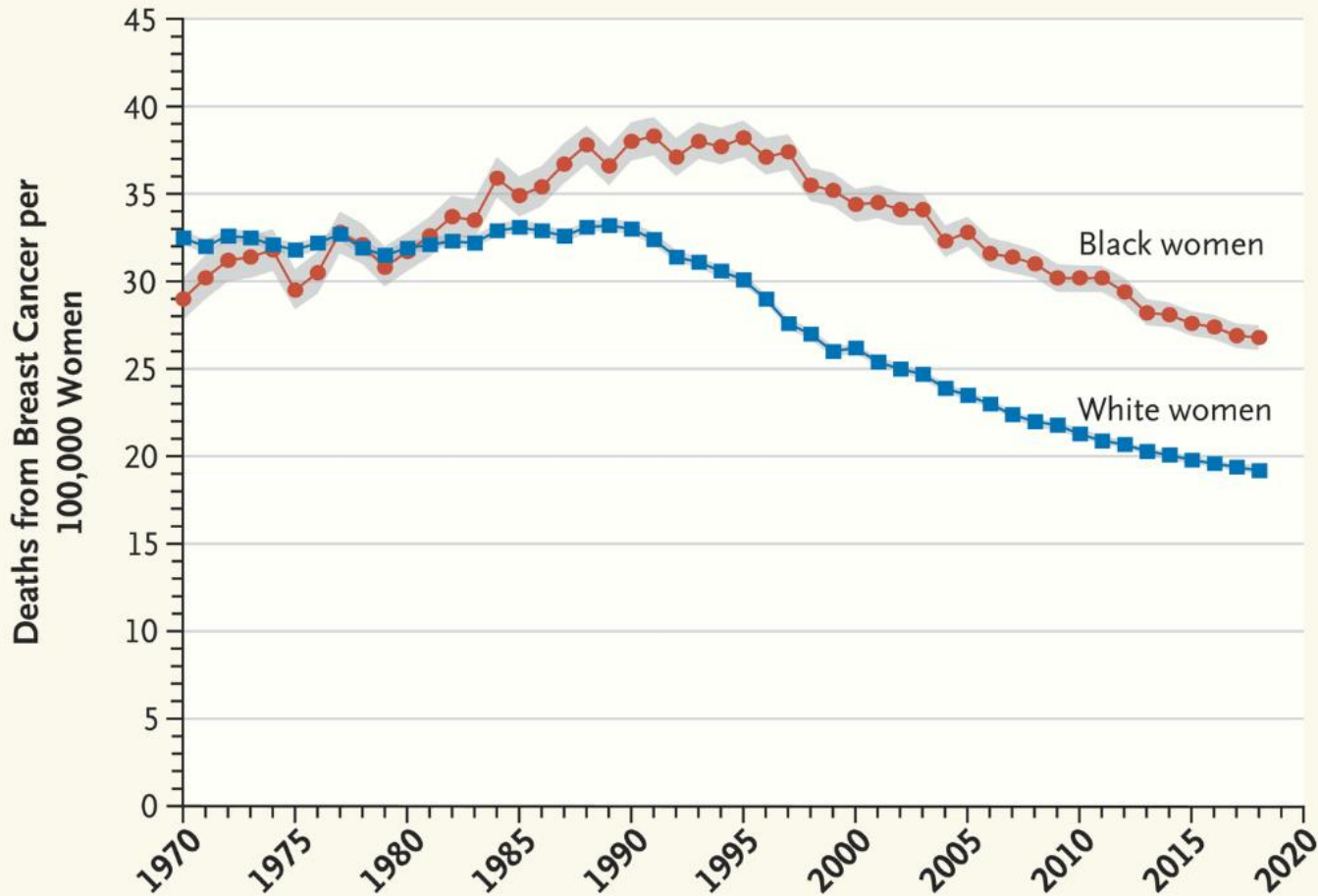


**FEMALE BREAST CANCER:
AGE-ADJUSTED RATE OF NEW CASES PER 100,000 WOMEN BY RACE/ETHNICITY**

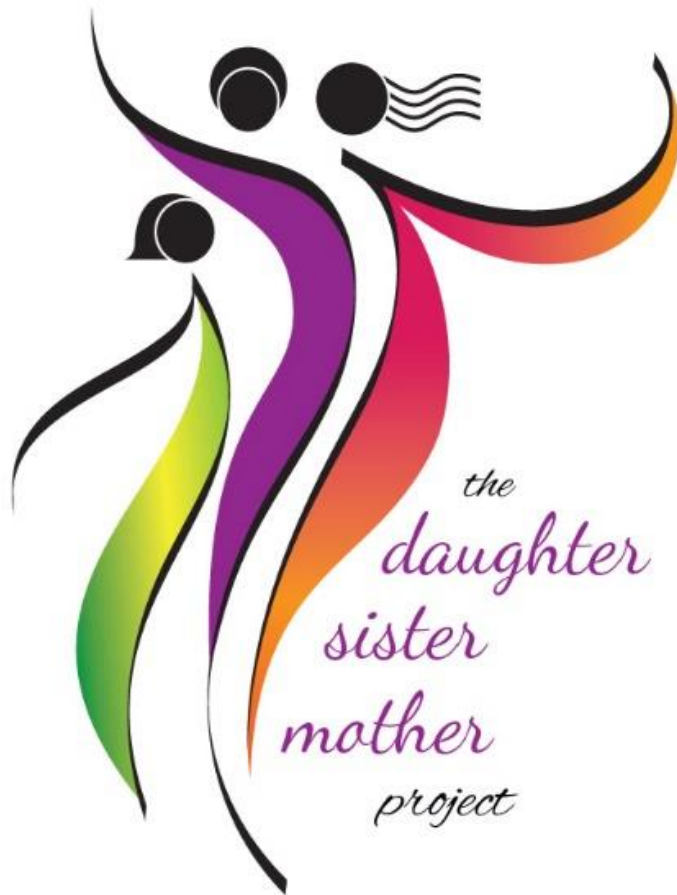


**FEMALE BREAST CANCER:

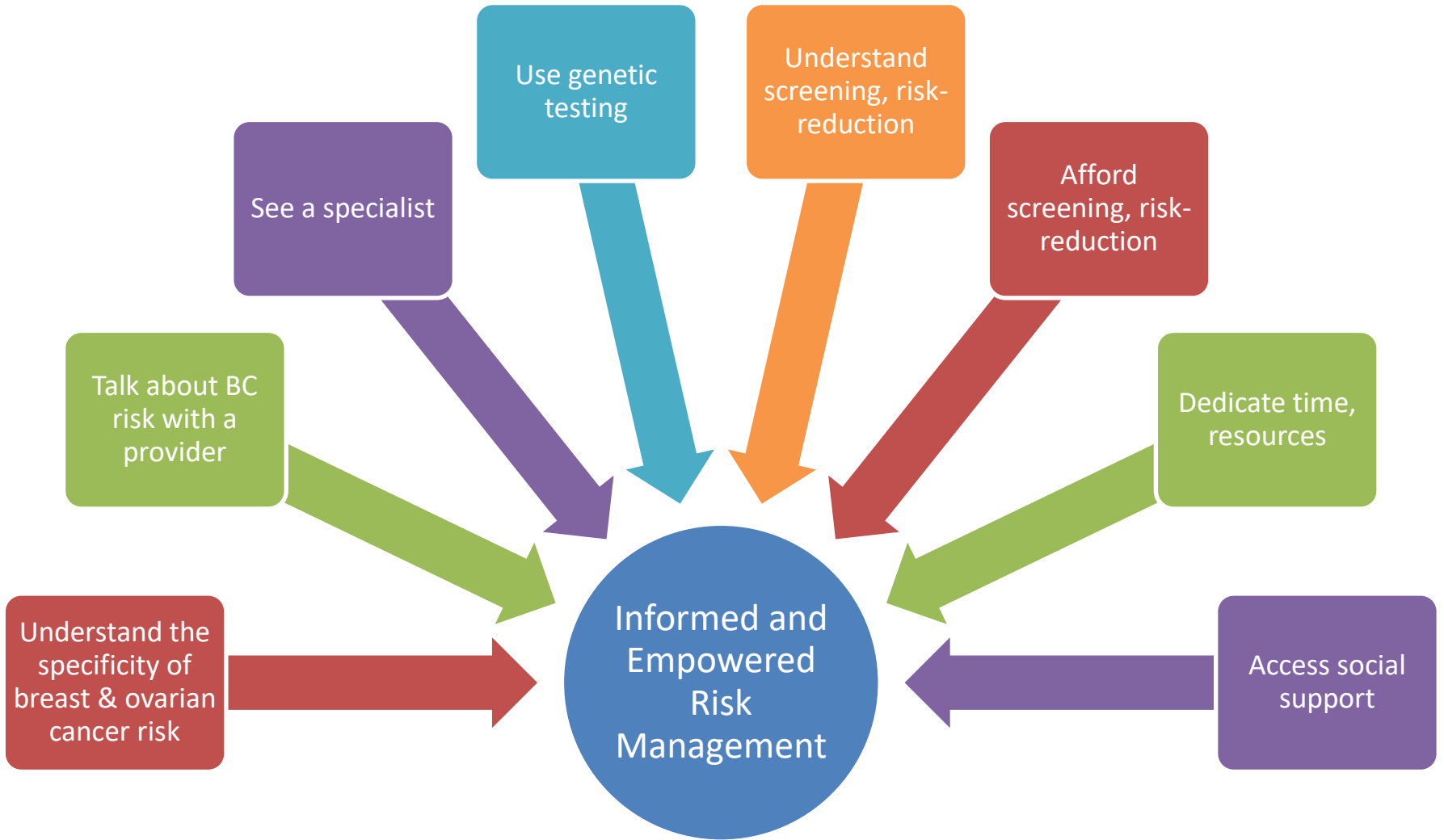
