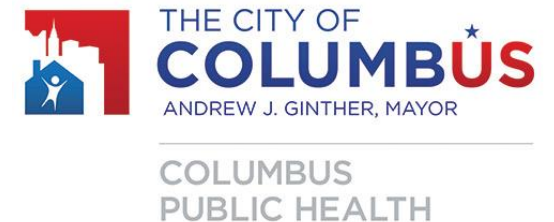

1) What is REDCap?



REDCap is:

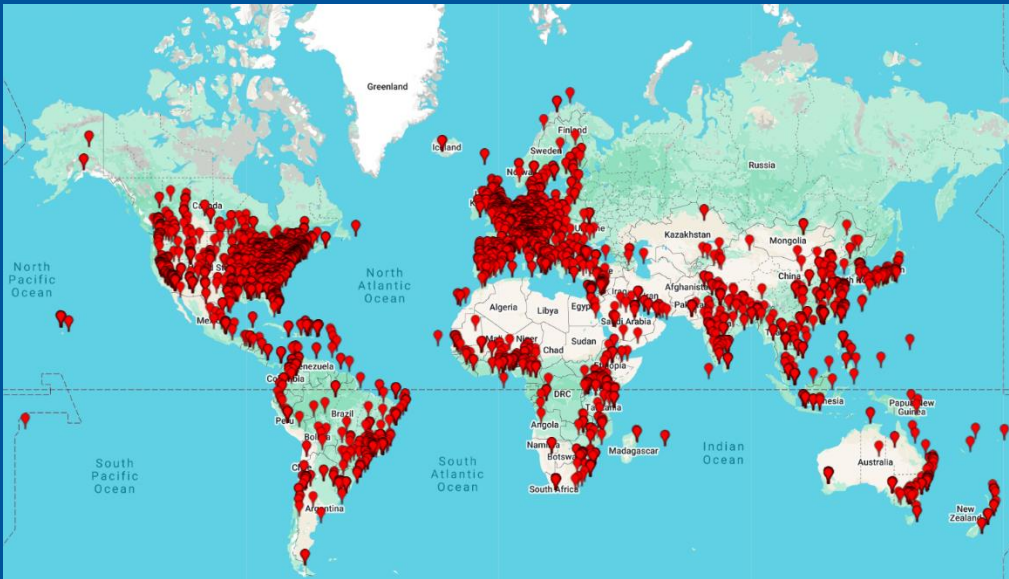
a web-based application developed by Vanderbilt University for building and managing online surveys and databases

REDCap is:

- Free
- HIPAA-compliant & secure
- A tool for data collection & management
- Able to export data to various analysis programs
- Used by 7,456 institutions in 159 countries

How REDCap works:

- Available at no charge to nonprofit organizations
- Your organization is responsible for installation & support, as well as administration (user accounts & permissions)
- Users access it from anywhere via a web browser



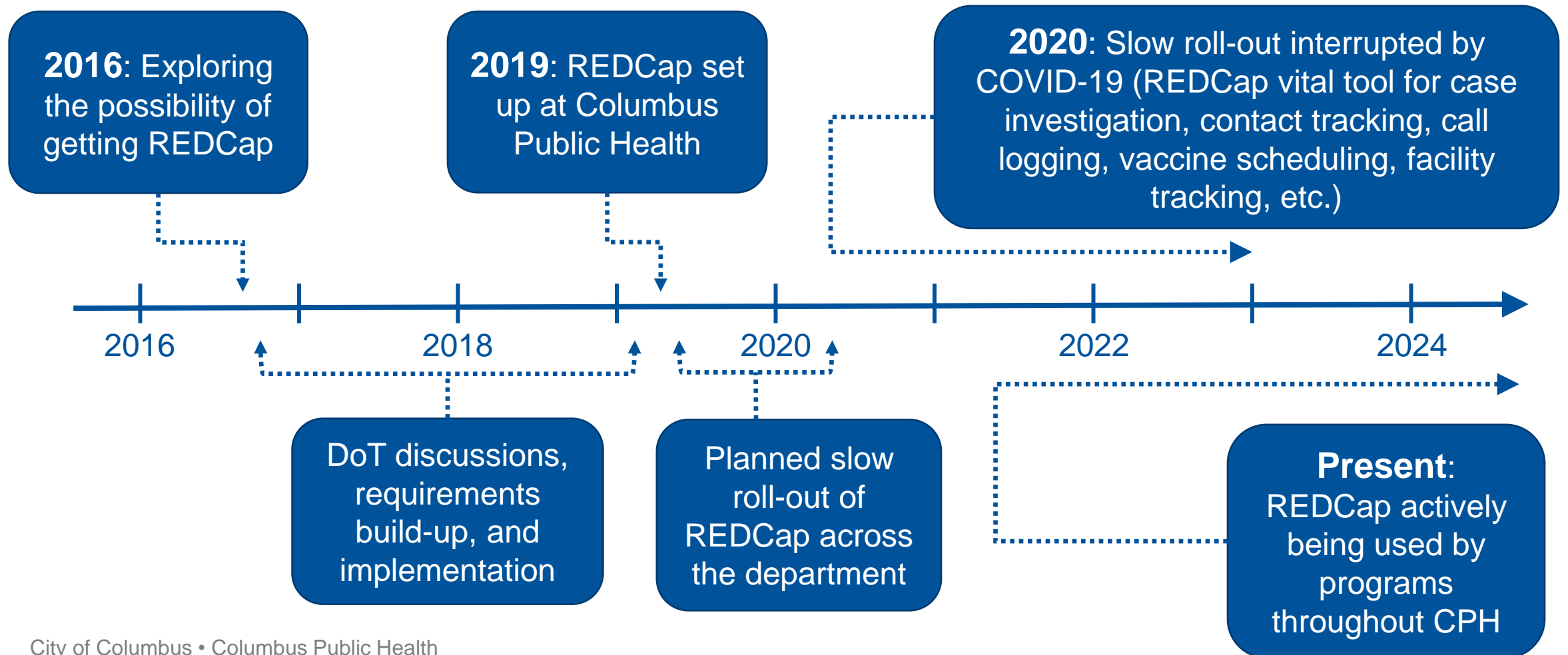
REDCap Features



- Highly customizable
- Simple to create, copy, modify, and/or share projects
- Advanced capabilities and many design & functionality options
- Tracks user activity
- Ability to create a survey in multiple languages

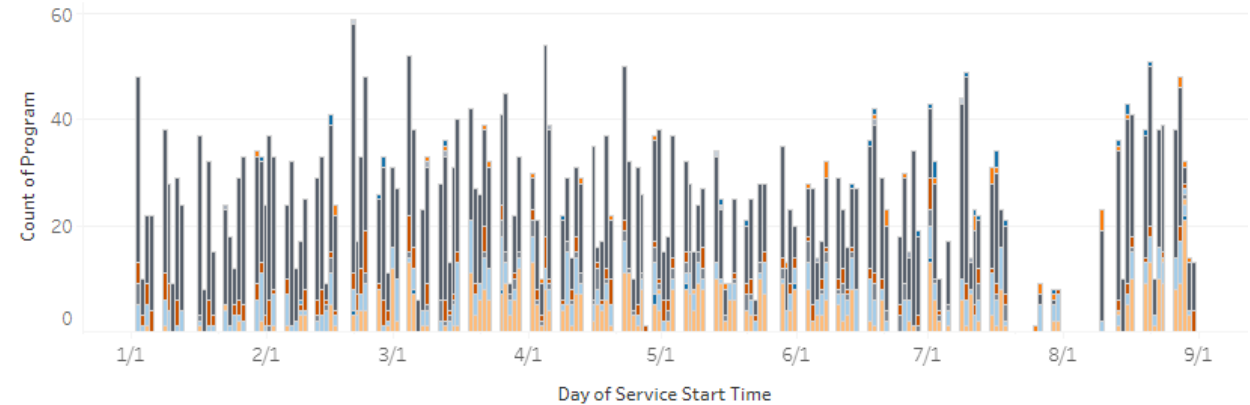

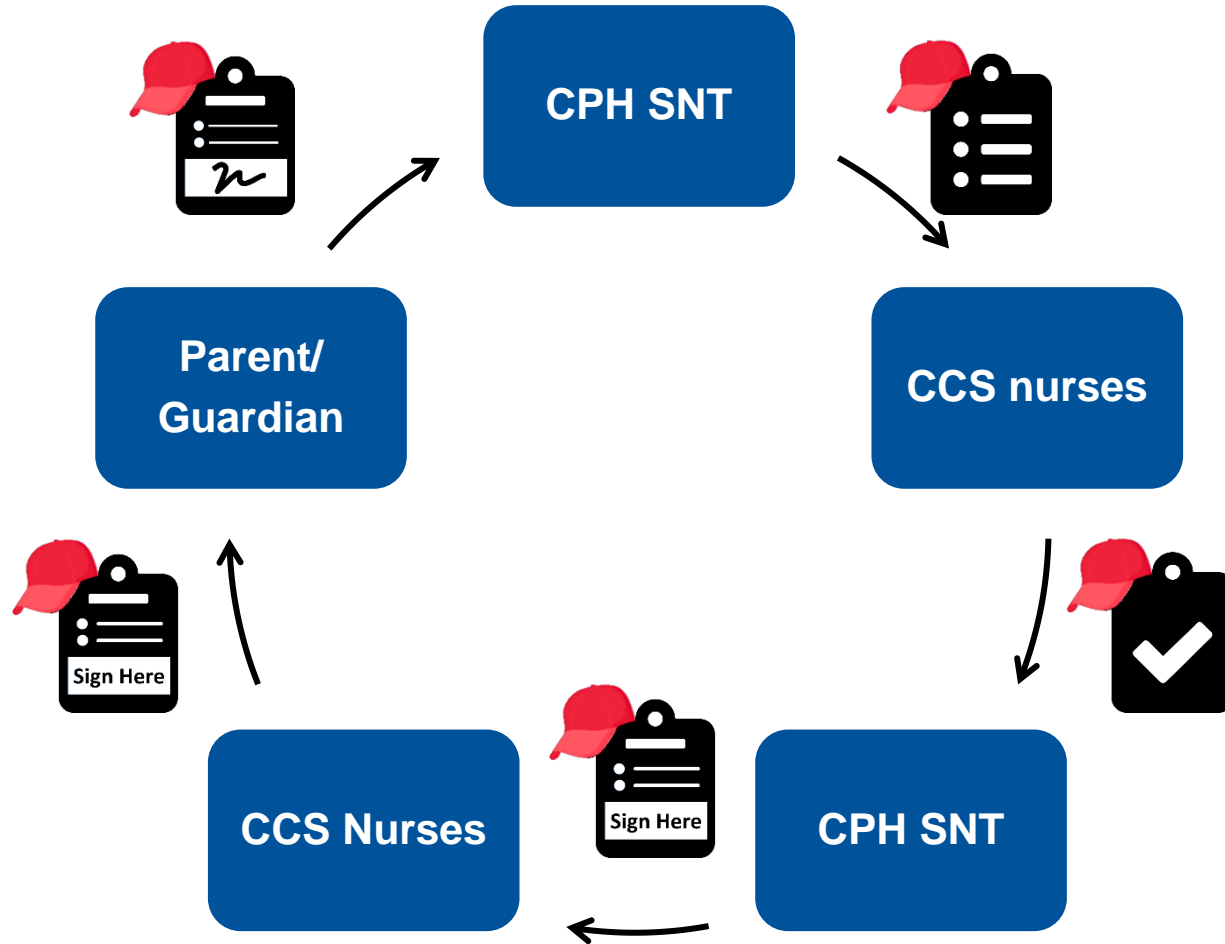

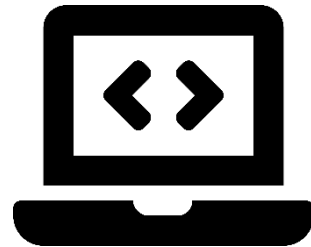

General Project Creation Flow



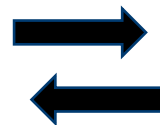
Requirements

- Discuss and agree on requirements and scope
- Gather existing resources, e.g. instruments or dictionaries



Development

- Initiate REDCap project build-out per requirements
- On-going discussions and updates
- Troubleshooting



Testing

- Test instruments (forms/surveys) data gathering (fake), email alerts and invitations, workflows, etc.
- Compile changes needed/issues



Deployment

- Place project in production/delete fake test data
- Add additional REDCap users + rights if necessary
- Distribute survey link/QR code if necessary



4) Advantages of REDCap

Some advantages include:

Easy sharing between all staff working on a project, with the ability to limit user permissions as desired.

Automatic tracking of changes to project data, so that accidental deletions or edits can be recovered.

An import feature, so that data in platforms such as Excel can be easily moved into REDCap.

An export feature, so data collected in REDCap can be put into a data analysis program.

HIPAA-protected data can be safely collected and stored.



Flexibility

- One form or many
- Single instances, repeating instruments, or longitudinal events
- Public surveys, surveys available only by an email invitation, or forms that you have to log into REDCap to access
- More than a dozen types of fields, and many validations to control the kind of data collected

Security

- HIPAA-compliance means PHI can be securely collected and stored
- User roles control who can export data, delete forms, change settings, etc.
- Data Access Groups can be set up so users only see the data they need
- A log records any changes to the project or data by users



Works with other systems

- **Import data** in .csv format from other data systems or excel tracking
 - **Export data** to use in analysis or data visualization programs
 - **API** allows for connections that automatically retrieve or modify REDCap data





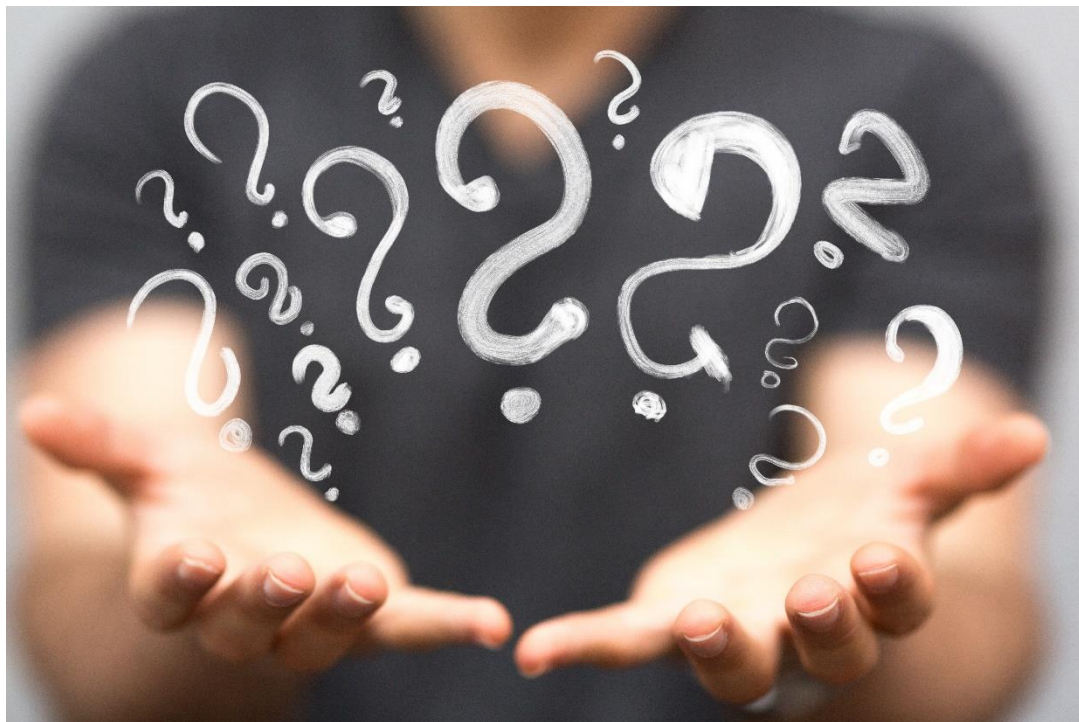
Collaboration

- Programs can work together on the same project – easy to share data, multiple users can be logged in at once
- Projects can be shared with other health departments – simple to choose what aspects of the project to export, and to create a new project based on someone else's .xml or data dictionary

Extra Features

- Smart variables
- Piping
- Embedding
- Special functions / calculations
- Hide fields / options when needs change





5) Process & Considerations for Using REDCap at your LHD



Pre-Implementation

- Buy-in (Departmental Administration)
- REDCap Administrator Guides/Process
- Roll-out planning
- Training (app. administrators and user)
- Dedicated team (both at LHD and DoT)
- Use cases (RC versus other tools)

If you build it, they will come

Post-Implementation

- Hardware scaling (volume)
- Staff scaling (IT and App. Users)
- Upgrades and Downtime
- Use REDCap to use REDCap



Challenges



Do I *have* to use REDCap?

What happened to Survey Monkey?

But my program needs help too!

I really don't like change.

My data is fine the way it is.

Our REDCap Life Recap

- Early Years: *baby steps / dabbling in REDCap*



- Teenage Years: *this is useful and cool stuff!*
